Slavery & Human Trafficking Policy


ID Systems UK Ltd acknowledges the provisions of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and will ensure transparency within our organisation and with suppliers of goods and services to the company. The business is satisfied from its own due diligence there is no evidence of any act of modern day slavery or human trafficking within its own company.

As part of the ID Systems UK due diligence processes into slavery and human trafficking the supplier approval process incorporates a review of the controls undertaken by the supplier. Imported goods from sources outside the UK and EU are potentially more at risk of slavery and human trafficking issues. The level of management control required for these sources will be continually monitored.

ID Systems UK will not knowingly support or deal with any business involved in slavery or human trafficking.

ID Systems UK will undertake responsibility for implementing this Policy Statement and its objectives.

This Policy Statement will be reviewed and published annually or sooner if there is a change in legislation, process or significant increase in staffing levels.
